As a recent high school graduate, I decided to seek out summer employment before heading to college in the fall. As most of us already know, these are hard times economically; many are struggling to make ends meet.

So in the process of following up on some assignments for *Wrangler News*, I had a conversation with a Kyrene School District staff member who told me a story that touched my heart and made me realize the kind of community we live in. The participants in this account wish to remain anonymous, so their names are omitted. Here's the story:

A mom was waiting to register her daughter for summer classes when she noticed another mother in line in front of her. The second mom, who had four children, apparently had been told that she qualified for a scholarship to allow her kids to attend summer classes tuition-free. Unknown to her, however, was that

such scholarships allow for kids to attend only one class at no charge.

So when she reached the registration desk, she had to say she couldn't afford to pay for the additional classes. The woman in line behind her managed to overhear the discussion, and as the disappointed mom began to leave the first one walked up the registrar and whispered

that she would like to pay the extra tuition.

"It was just the right thing to do in my mind," the first mother said later. "I can easily not go out to eat for a while or not shop (for non-necessities) in order to allow these kids to attend summer school."

So she paid the additional fees that were needed to get the other woman's kids enrolled in classes, which they are now said to be attending.

Such were the details of this anonymous, random act of kindness, a spontaneous act from a stranger who was willing to open not only her heart but her wallet.

As I heard this recounted over the phone I thought, "Wow, what an amazing story."

In our lives we all have had our ups and downs, our triumphs and struggles. But how many of us have had some one there to help pick us up in our difficult times?

## Holds his spot among top 20 on 'So You Think You Can Dance' Teen advances in opening weeks of popular TV competition

“Kill it”—words that describe exactly what 2007 Corona del Sol graduate **Ade Obayomi** does every time he hits the dance floor in the popular hit TV summer show *So You Think You Can Dance*. “Ade is a great guy and an awesome dancer,” said **Taylor Laing**, who took dance classes and performed with Ade at Corona. “I’ll never forget him saying ‘kill it’ before almost every performance.”

*So You Think You Can Dance* is similar to Fox’s *American Idol*, except that dancers instead of singers try out in auditions held across the nation to earn a spot as one of the top 20 dancers to make it to the weekly TV show.

Then, every week, the contestants display different dance-style performances put together by some of the top choreographers in the business, hoping to receive enough votes from audiences at home to remain on the show for another week.

So far, three weeks into the season, Ade has received nothing but positive comments from all three judges, and has never ended up in the bottom three. Contestants in that ranking have to dance for their lives because two competitors are cut from every show the first few weeks.

“Ade has always been such a stunning dancer,”

said Corona senior **Danielle Willoughby**. “His fluidity of movement and skill in all forms of dance make him quite exceptional.”

It is unusual to see someone who grew up to be as tall as Ade (judge Mary Murphy called him the gentle giant) turn out to be such a talented dancer. But he not only has style and technique, Ade is unique in every way, from the “lucky pick” he wears sticking out of his hair during dance rehearsals to his full name, Adetokunbo Isaac Kayode Obayomi.

Ade’s dad, Jake, is from Nigeria. Jake met Ade’s mom, Janet, while studying to become an engineer at a college in St. Louis 30-plus years ago. They moved to Arizona for Jake to take a job as an engineer for Honeywell Aerospace, and both Ade and his sister, Bukola, were born here.

“Ade became interested in dance when he was four and took pre-school tumbling and tap from **Kathy Bauman** at First Presbyterian Academy,” said **Janet Obayomi**.

“He made quite an impression on his teacher—so much so that she recommended that we put him in professional lessons, which we did and have never regretted.”

Ade’s dance specialty is probably considered contemporary but he also has a background in

## New rules said to be more user friendly

# Changes to Tempe's towing ordinance take effect June 29

Changes are in the wind that should make an inconvenient occurrence less stressful.

In late May, the Tempe City Council unanimously approved modifications to the city's towing ordinance.

The changes take effect Monday, June 29.

One of the changes will relate to proof of ownership. Under the revised ordinance, a current rental or lease agreement will now be acceptable proof of ownership for the towed vehicle.

If the person's documents are in the vehicle, the private towing company is, upon request, obligated to allow the claimant to retrieve them from the

vehicle to provide proof of ownership.

Having a vehicle towed is an inconvenience. However, **Sgt. Steve Carbajal** said the recent changes will make it less stressful.

"It makes it easier for the person who gets their car towed, as far as outlining what tow companies can do and what they can't do and what they can charge for and what they cannot charge for," Carbajal said.

"I think that's the biggest difference in the new ordinance."

The changes give increased protection for claimants who have had their vehicles towed while also maintaining enforcement of parking violations. At times a person can step outside to find their vehicle has disappeared, not knowing whether it was towed or stolen.

Under the revised ordinance, private towing companies are required to notify the Tempe Police Department prior to towing, immobilizing or transporting a vehicle. This will allow police an opportunity to resolve the issue regarding whether it was towed

or stolen.

It allows the owner of the vehicle to have an opportunity to be notified in advance.

The previous ordinance allowed tow companies to make that notification within one hour of the tow.

A claimant can also pay towing and storage fees with a credit or debit card. (The new ordinance will prohibit the tow company from charging additional fees for those forms of payment.)

The ordinance also prohibits two companies from charging any fees not specifically authorized by the Tempe City Code.

Carbajal said the new ordinance will help residents in the event they do have their vehicles towed.

Examining the area and making sure the vehicle is not parked in a prohibited area is one thing which can be done to prevent a tow.

Carbajal said understanding the new ordinance will give area residents an advantage.

"I think it's important that people get themselves familiarized with the new ordinance and what their rights are when it comes to a situation when the vehicle has been towed," he said.

Jersey's Tavern & Grill prides itself on doing special things in the community. Its usual function is to give area residents a place to relax and have a good time, but last week it made an impact in a different way:

It held a benefit to support families of public safety members and the Hunger Club.

During the first hour, Jersey's gave away free pizzas. For the rest of the night, the bar donated \$3 from every pizza sold and \$2 from every burger and Philly cheese steak. Gift certificates were also auctioned.

Jersey's owner **Dennis Delaney** said helping the community is something he enjoys doing.

"At the end of the day it makes you feel good," he said. "It really does."

Former Philadelphia Eagles football players Mark McMillan and Byron Evans also have contacted the bar.

McMillan and Evans made an appearance at the event. They have an Internet radio show called Hard Hittin' Radio, and incorporated the show into their appeal.

"They were looking for another bar to sponsor the Eagles and become an Eagles bar during football season," Delaney said.

"So we decided to join forces. We're hoping they'll be able to get quite a few of the Valley's Eagles fans (to attend)."

When it opened two years ago, Jerseys adopted a sports theme.

"I have football jerseys, baseball jerseys—all kind of jerseys around," he said. "But (the name Jersey's) has a double-meaning, because they nicknamed me 'Jersey.' I happen to be from New Jersey."

Jersey's has also been selected as a location for a documentary being made, titled "The Green Fans: The Movie."



"It's about how far-reaching the Eagles' (fan base stretches)," Delaney said. "I was the bar they chose for two reasons. One is I happen to be an Eagles fan from south Jersey. People all think I'm a New York Giants fan or New York Jets fan, but I was in south Jersey—45 minutes from Center City, Philadelphia."

Delaney can't help but get excited about the movie, in which he has been told he will have a part.

"I'm looking forward to it. I'm hoping it works out good for us," he said. "Anything that helps our community around here (brings a sense of pride)."

The second reason was based on the film makers' impressions of the bar's atmosphere.

"I have a nice, friendly staff," Delaney said. "We try to take care of our customers."

The congenial bar also features live music, most of which is classic rock. Delaney said he's looking for some good country and rhythm-and-blues bands. He said the artists give the customers an enjoyable experience.

"Some of the musicians are terrific," he said. "Our bar is a local, small bar. We have live

music and never a cover charge."

Jersey's is a place where fans can watch sports and enjoy a diverse menu, Delaney said. Sandwiches, burgers, pizza, chicken wings and salads are just some of the items featured on the menu.

A little over a year ago, Delaney started a new program, offering a bus service that gives customers a safe way to reach home if they have pushed their limit beyond the drinking-and-driving safety zone.

"We've been running it for the better part of 18 months. We bring them into our place, and when they want to go home, we take them,"

Delaney said.

"People are going to drink. People are going to go out and have a good time. But do we want to keep our communities safe? Yes, we do. That's why I bought the bus."

With so much happening, Delaney said Jersey's has not lost its focus of maintaining its reputation as an enjoyable venue. He said he has no plans to stop tradition.

"I'm hoping I can make this my home for a long, long time," he said.

## Nonprofits garner Foundation funding

Six nonprofit organizations have received a combined \$7,656—\$1,276 each—in grant funding from Tempe Community Foundation.

The organizations were selected based on recommendations from a citizen review board organized by Tempe Community Council.

Agencies receiving funding were A New Leaf Men's Shelter, NewTown Community Development Corporation, Tempe Salvation Army, ARC of Tempe,

The Centers for Habilitation and Tumbleweed Youth.

Tempe Community Foundation, one of 13 affiliates of Arizona Community Foundation, is a permanent endowment fund working in cooperation with Tempe Community Council.

The grant funding was provided from the endowment's interest, which is distributed once a year to human-service agencies applying for city of Tempe financial support.

## 2008-09: A memorable year in review

### Aztecs amass a stellar record for final appearance in AIA Central Region

Corona del Sol athletes had a stellar 2008-09 season in their last year in the Central region before transitioning to compete in the East Valley region next fall.

“We had four state champions, two state finalists and nine Central Region champions,” said Cds athletic director **Dan Nero**.

“We were also the first public school in Arizona history to place both the boys and girls tennis teams in the state finals.”

#### State 5A-I State Championship Badminton

— The Lady Aztecs beat defending state champions Mountain Pointe Oct. 22 to win Corona’s first Badminton state championship. The closest Corona had ever gotten was the year before when they were the 2007 state champion finalists losing to Mountain Pointe in the finals. Corona ended the season 17-1—only losing to Mountain Pointe earlier in the season.

The championship match went down to the wire with Corona’s **Alexa Hay** and **Brittany Messer** defeating Mountain Pointe’s doubles team 15-8, 5-15 and 15-10 when Hay executed a perfect drop shot for the winning point for a 5-4 win.

Corona had started off winning the first three singles matches to take a 3-0 lead when **Amy Davis**, **Messer** and **Julie Simpson** defeated Pride’s top three players. **Resma Amin** gave Corona a 4-2 lead when she was victorious at the No. 6 spot before the teams headed into doubles play. Hay and Messer got the point Corona needed to defeat Mountain Pointe

5-4 in the last match.

**Davis** was a state finalist in the individual championship match held Oct. 25. **Davis** also received a Tempe All-City Award for badminton at the Tempe All-City Association Awards banquet held Jan. 12 where she gave the invocation. Coach **Katie Inskeep** was honored by the All-City Association for leading the Lady Aztecs to the state championship.

**Katherine Cai**, a member of the state championship badminton team, also had an astounding academic career at Corona. She was recently chosen as a recipient of one of Arizona’s 20 Flinn Scholarships, which include funding for four years of study, academic-focused travel abroad, mentorship by top faculty and other benefits worth more than \$50,000 on top of her tuition.

#### State 5A-I State Championship Wrestling

— The Corona del Sol Wrestling team took home its first state championship Feb. 28 and their second consecutive overall individual championship. The Aztecs defeated three-year defending state champions Mesa 25-24 when three-time state individual champion **Luke Macchiaroli** convinced 30-year head coach **Dave Vibber** that he should switch places with **Mike Howard** in the final two matches of the tournament.

Corona won six of the last seven matches including Howard’s and Macchiaroli’s matches to defeat Mesa and take home the 5A-I state team wrestling championship.

Corona won the overall individual 5A-I state tournament with four champions from the individual tournament: **Ryan Miller** at 145 pounds; **Derek Felton**, 60 pounds; **Luke Macchiaroli**, 215 pounds; and **Mike Howard** (L) HWT. The other individual state finishers included **Justin Cullins** who placed fifth in the 112-pound weight class; **Ryan Cox** third at 119 pounds; **Kasey Turner** fourth at 130; **Blake Ortiz** third at 152; and **Sam Fulton** sixth at 171.

Eight Corona wrestlers were recognized and received Tempe All-City Winter Awards: **Ryan Cox**, 119 pounds; **Kevin Etchells**, 125 pounds; **Kasey Turner**, 130 pounds; **Ryan Miller**, 145 pounds; **Blake Ortiz**, 145 pounds; **Derek Felton**, 145 pounds; **Luke Macchiaroli**, 171 pounds; and **Mike Howard**, 215 pounds.

**Felton** and **Macchiaroli** were named Co-MVPs, **David Hoover** received the Joe Sellah Award and **Ortiz** was voted by his teammates as most improved.

#### State 5A-I State Championship Baseball

— The Aztec baseball team won Corona’s second state championship by defeating defending state champion Hamilton 11-1 on May 16. The game was called in the sixth inning because of the Arizona high school baseball ten-run rule. The only other time Cds has won the championship was in 1993.

Shortstop **Kirby Pellant**, second base **Ryan Moore** and utility player **Evan Ritchey** were named to the Central region first team. **Greg Ryan** was named to the second team and **Erik Wanta** received Honorable Mention.

The Aztecs captured their first Central region championship title in years after defeating Desert Vista on April 28. Cds lost to Desert Vista in two early April games before getting on a roll to defeat the Thunder three straight games—twice in the state tournament.

Four Aztec players received the Tempe All-City award at the spring sports banquet: **Felton**, second base; **Pellant**, short stop; **Moore**, outfield; and **Tyler Giannonatti**, utility.

**Felton**, infield, and **Moore**, outfield, were also named to the Class 5A baseball All-State first team while **Giannonatti**, utility, and **Pellant**, infield, were awarded honorable mention.

Coach Dave Webb was named the *Arizona Republic’s* All-Southeast Valley Coach of the Year. **Felton** and **Moore** were also named to the All-Southeast Valley baseball team. **Pellant** was selected June 11 in the 38th round of the MLB amateur draft by the Las Angeles Dodgers. He has signed a letter-of-intent to play at Marshall University in the fall. **Vibber** received the 5A-1 Coach of the Year award.

#### 5A State Finalists Girls Tennis

— The Lady Aztec girls tennis team finished the season 17-2 garnering several awards on their way to a runner-up finish to Salpointe in the state 5A-1 team championships. Junior **Kelly Lawson** finished the season undefeated in both singles and doubles play and was named Central Region Player of the Year. Coach **Carol Sandvig** was named Central Region Coach of the Year.

Other members of the team that contributed to the Central Region Championship trophy, first place in the All City Tournament and second place in the Metrocenter’s Kiwanis Invitational included **Lauren Hacker**, **Danielle Hoyme**, **Kristen Ohe**, **Michelle Wellnitz** and **Libby Vogt**.





## 'Ice Age: Dawn of the Dinosaurs'

With kids, as a rule, you can't go too far wrong offering dinosaurs. The 2002 computer-animated kids' film Ice Age, and its 2006 sequel Ice Age: The Meltdown, were set in the frigid title period of prehistory, a mere 20,000 years ago, long after the dinosaurs were extinct (about 60 million years ago).

Accordingly, its major characters were woolly mammoths, saber-toothed cats, ground sloths and other such titanic and iconic ancient mammals: still very cool, of course, but for most kids (including this former kid) not on quite the same level of off-the-hook coolness as dinosaurs.

So for the third Ice Age movie, called Ice Age: Dawn of the Dinosaurs, the filmmakers have done what filmmakers have always done when they wanted to include dinos in a story set eons too late: They cheated, and just fancifully let the great beasts in.

Once again, the heroes are Manny the Mammoth (voiced by Ray Romano), whose mate Ellie (Queen Latifah) is soon to give birth, Diego the Saber-Tooth (Denis Leary), and the lisping, waddling, bottomlessly sweet Sid the Sloth (John Leguizamo).

The latter, in a fit of frustrated parental instinct, impulsively "adopts" three unhatched eggs he finds in an ice cave.

The eggs turn out to be from a hidden, subterranean lost valley teeming with the giant reptiles, and the hatchlings turn out to be young carnivorous dinosaurs.

They adore Sid, but he's clearly not an appropriate parent, being, for one thing, a vegetarian.

Sid ends up carried off by the hatchlings' very angry real mother, and his friends must enter the lost land to rescue him.

Along the way they meet an intrepid and slightly crazy weasel voiced by Simon Pegg, who serves as their guide.

Ice Age: DOTD seemed to me a lesser, cornier, cheesier affair than either of its predecessors, but there was still much that I enjoyed about it, and the kids at the screening I saw seemed to as well.

Leguizamo is very funny once again, and there's real panache to the crosscutting in the finale.

Some of the dinosaurs and other primordial creatures, however anachronistic, also add fun and spectacle to the proceedings.

But, as in the first two films, the highlights are the wordless efforts of Scrat, the hapless squirrel-thingy, to protect his precious acorn.

This time around Scrat, a scrawny critter with a raccoon-like tail and a long canine muzzle with snaggly fangs, who moves in wary spurts and vocalizes only in irritable clucks and anguished wails, is given a love interest/rival for his acorn, and his divided loyalties add a new dimension to him. Though Leguizamo comes close, nothing else in Ice Age: DOTD is as funny as Scrat's riotous interludes.

There's probably no compliment in all of animation than to say that a character or scene is worthy of the late great Chuck Jones, and Scrat earns it.

## Kyrene Summer Theatre a creative diversion for kids

# Too late for this year, but popular program due for 2010 return

During the summer, parents confront the perennial challenge of finding ways to get their children off the couch.

While the heat bears down outside, the Disney channel and Nickelodeon lure audiences inside. But, everyone knows, better options are out there.

One of those is the Kyrene Summer Theatre Program. competitive gymnastics and has taken a variety of dance classes over the years. These include the ballet and modern jazz classes he took when his family moved to Montreal, Canada, where his dad's job took them in 1999.

While in Canada, Ade's love for dance and performing was further enhanced when he was picked to dance in a Montreal Nutcracker ballet production and was cast for a made-for-television movie, "A Diva's Christmas

Carol" starring Vanessa Williams.

"By the time we moved back to the U.S. in 2001, Ade had starred in several local television commercials, two end-of-the-year school musicals and one TV pilot episode," said Janet Obayomi. "We lived in Wichita, Kan., for two years before moving back to Phoenix in 2003."

"Ade has always been an amazing dancer," said **Lina Washington**, a 2008 Corona graduate.

"He would always get standing ovations whenever he performed his solos for competition, yet he's always been so humble about his gift."

This season was the second time Ade had tried out to be a show contestant. Last summer he made it to the Las Vegas round before being cut during the ballroom dancing portion. He applied for and was accepted to study in the Performing Arts program at Chapman College in Orange, Calif. He wasn't sure he would even try out this season.


